This is a short report on the Concord Grape industry and market. If you have no interest in Concord, please view the products we handle described on pages 3 and 4. We are industrial food brokers/traders specializing in fruit juices, concentrates, purees, essences, frozen, dried and powdered fruits and nuts. The **2005 Concord** harvest in the US produced an amazing 563,160 tons, 83,460 tons or 17% more than the previous record high tonnage of 479,700 produced in 1999. Normally a large crop is associated with below average quality but 05 was an exception. All of the production areas saw well above average yields per acre and average to above average quality, as well. The juice and concentrate produced from this crop are of very good quality and are being offered at reduced prices to move the volume.

Eastern cash buyers reduced their prices paid growers only slightly from last year but they were the lowest in 10 years. Washington processors paid growers the lowest price since the 60's.


No losses to fall freezes were reported even though the harvest took longer than usual.

Prices of Concord juice and concentrate opened at their lowest levels since we started recording them in 1984. This was done to move the huge crop and should encourage processors who had reduced or eliminated Concord from their formulas to switch back. The prices for red grape concentrate from California and South America are now close to or higher than the price of Concord.


No winter injury has occurred as of early March and prospects for the 06 crop are at about average in all 3 growing areas. However, there is <u>no ice in Lake Erie</u> due to a mild winter which increases the threat of spring frosts in the major Eastern Concord growing area.

Ontario: The Concord crop was off 25% from last year and grower prices were down slightly.


Brazil: Harvest is underway with estimates of a 40% reduction in yields due to drought and hail damage. The grower price is not set yet.



The '05 crop was the largest in history even with no increase in acreage. Prior to 05 the 10 year average was 395,980.



Prices paid growers dropped slightly in the East but hit bottom (?) in the west. Growers are very concerned.



Concords were over priced vs red and white grape concentrates commencing in 1996 causing the 10 year slide due to reduced demand. 05 prices reflect the need to sell the huge crop and to entice end users to use more Concord in their products.
